- Local performance data is below state performance data.
- 4. Inconsistent implementation of policies and procedures throughout the school district is evident.
- Less than 20% of student files reviewed identify compliance issues.
- School-wide improvement strategies are necessary to address concerns.
- Conflicting responses (positive or negative) to survey questions.

NOT ACCEPTABLE
